

# OPEN LETTER TO OMERS


We the undersigned cleaners at 401 West Georgia and Marine Building exercised our right to join a union. The BC Labour Relations Board recognized our union vote and subsequent successorship application on September 28, 2019.

We have asked Bee-Clean to sit down and bargain a collective agreement with us and our fellow co-workers at 1055 West Hastings, but until today have not been given any dates for bargaining.

It has also come to our attention that Bee-Clean has raised more legal challenges to our successorship application and wants the Labour Board to re-consider the decision made on September 28 - a decision that guaranteed our right to continue working at these Oxford Properties buildings, where some of us have been working as long as 13 years.

We are calling on the owners of these Oxford Properties buildings - The Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System (OMERS) to require Bee-Clean to be a responsible contractor and respect our wishes to have a union and collectively bargain a collective agreement.
